	Germany, Susanne joined the Institute for Health & Consumer Protection
	(IHCP) which is part of the Joint Research Centre (JRC) of the European
	Commission. Susanne became a team member of the European Centre for
	the Validation of Alternative Methods (ECVAM) in 1995 where she was
	involved in formal validation studies of toxicological in vitro tests detecting
	embryotoxicity and endocrine disruption as well as the regulatory
	acceptance of some tests at the OECD. She collaborated in several FP6 and
	FP 7 projects including the public/privat partnership initiative "SEURAT-1".
	She contributed to more than 70 peer-reviewed scientific paper.
